

Project Summary

Auditorium Sound System Upgrade – Gettysburg Area High School

Project Purpose

The proposed project would replace the current auditorium sound system. The existing system was installed when the school was constructed 19 years ago and has reached the end of its useful life. Technology has changed drastically over the past twenty years and many new components are not compatible with the old technology. Failures and/or glitches in the system have plagued the Administration with interruptions to school and district wide functions. The following is feedback received from one of our building Administrators: “I need an immediate assessment and correction of the sound system in the auditorium. I am beyond embarrassed. For the fourth consecutive event with parents, I have had to scrap the microphone and yell because the system does not work.”

Scope of Work

The awarded contractor will remove existing system and wiring. The installation of the replacement system will include all new components and wiring. The new system will be digitally controlled with an “Easy” option for users unfamiliar with the complex workings of an advanced sound system.
