Treasurer Report (Maria Kretz)

The balance as of last meeting was \$14,497.20. Deposits totaled \$4,777.00 which included t-shirts (apparel order), last chunk of Hershey Park tickets and 2nd grade chaperone payments. Withdrawals totaled \$1,672.33 which included rest of 2nd grade field trip, reimbursement for RIF, stipends, May Fair, and Teacher Appreciation Week. Total balance as of today is \$17,601.87. Big withdrawals on the horizon: May Fair (\$2300), 1st grade field trip (\$850) and bussing for field trips – this will happen over the summer, rest of Teacher Appreciation Week, and payment to Stricklands for apparel order.
