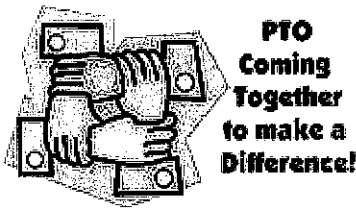

Please be aware that the only medications that the teachers are authorized to bring with them are inhalers and epi pens. If there is medication that you will want your child to have during the field trip you must send the medication in from home and make arrangements to have someone give that to your child. I cannot send it from school.

If your child has asthma, but you have not sent in an inhaler, you may want to consider doing that. Please send the inhaler with the proper medication permission form, signed by both you and your physician. Contact me if you need a permission form.

Don't forget sunscreen! For those days that your child will spend more time outside, on field trips or field day, please protect your child from sunburn.

For our 5th grade parents, remember that your child will need a physical exam for 6th grade. It's not too early to schedule that. A letter with the required physical form was sent home with your child.

Hope you are taking advantage of the warmer weather and getting outside! Remember, flip flops are a safety hazard and not allowed at Lincoln. Also we ask that the girls not wear tube tops, halter tops or spaghetti straps in school. Save those for the summer!
